

Sociology (major) and RRS (minor)

Minimum Units Required for Graduation: 120 units

With NO double/triple counting:

GE	48 units
Sociology Major	42 units
RRS Minor	19 units

109 units needed for major, minor, and GE

WITH double/triple counting from the RRS Minor (using suggested courses below), the student can complete these degrees **with only 91 units (saving 18 units).**

College of Ethnic Studies
RRS Minor: 19-21 units

Introductory Courses (3 units)

Select one of the following: (saves 3 GE units)

- **ETHS / RRS 100** Introduction to Ethnic Studies (D1)
- **ETHS / RRS 110** Critical Thinking and the Ethnic Studies Experience (A3)

Core Courses (minimum 9 units—choose 1 course from each of the 3 sections below);

Note: We have listed 9 units worth below; student will have to take 1 more course from sections C or D for a total of 12 units.

Section A: History and Politics

RRS 240 All Power to the People: Comparative Freedom Movements of the “Sixties” (D2; saves 3 GE units)

Section B: Popular Culture, Literature, and the Arts

RRS 285 Race, Sports, and Society (D10; saves 3 GE units)

RRS 450 / ARAB 450 Contemporary Arabic and Arab American Literature (UD-C; saves 3 GE units)

Section C and D: 1 more course

CSL Course: 1-3 units

RRS Electives (Choose 1 of the following:)

- **RRS 330 / SOC 330:** Comparative Race and Ethnicity in the U.S.: Class, Gender, and Nation (UD-D & Soc; saves 3 GE units and 3 Soc units)
- **RRS 580 / SOC 580:** Educational Equality (UD-D & Soc; saves 3 GE units and 3 Soc units)

NOTE: Students can choose RRS 460 (AIDS and People of Color in the U.S.) instead. This course also counts towards UD-D (GE) but not Sociology; so they save 3 units instead of 6.
